## Apprentices with Disabilities

Support for Apprentices with Disabilities (SAWD) is intended to assist Colleges of Applied Arts and Technology (CAATs) to support people with special needs to participate in apprenticeship programs, pre-apprenticeship programs and Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Programs (OYAP). SAWD is to be used for accommodation and accessibility needs of apprentices with disabilities attending colleges across Ontario. SAWD improves access for apprentices with disabilities by ensuring they receive individualized services and have access to tools and technologies such as: interpreters and note-takers; and transcription of educational materials. SAWD supports apprenticeship students with disabilities to make a successful transition from apprenticeship to journeyperson and journeyperson to employment.
